# 1. Arrival & Transportation Support

1-1. There will be no Shuttle bus run by NIIED. GETS via recruiting companies should follow recruiting companies' instruction. This instruction is for GETS who applied for thru NIIED. After you arrive at Incheon Airport (Arrival Floor, 1F), please call Jin-su Park who is dispatched by NIIED on Sep. 25 to help you take the bus to NIIED. He will be there from 14:00 to 21:00 only, so please inform your arrival schedule in advance via e-mail if you need his help. Even though you can get his support, bus fare should be paid at your own cost.

In case you can't reach him, please call NIIED Staff, Soeyoung(010-3899-3928) and you can get some information.

1-2. After getting off the bus, you can reach NIIED on foot within 10 minutes, due to the heavy luggage, however, it's recommendable to take a taxi. If we get your exact arrival schedule, we can dispatch one of NIIED staff to the bus stop to help you.

# 2. Lost Luggage Protocol

2-1. Please plan for the possibility that your luggage could become lost or misplaced. Inquire with your airline ahead of time about how to retrieve lost luggage and pack some extra clothing in your carry-on.

2-2. If your luggage becomes lost, you should immediately contact the airline which was responsible for losing your luggage. You can do this by phone or by visiting the airline office at the airport (if your particular airline has an office at Incheon Int'l Airport).

**It is best to do this as soon as you discover that your luggage is missing.**

2-3. The airline will want a shipping address and contact info so that they can ship you your lost luggage. Please give them the following information:

※ Please note that the EPIK staff will do their best to assist you, but it is ultimately your responsibility to care for your lost luggage. If you do not receive your luggage by the end of the orientation date( Sep. 29), be sure to contact the airline to give them the new contact information of your new school or apartment.

### 3. Arriving on Your Own with Public Transportation in Korea

**3-1. From Incheon Int'l Airport to NIIED in Seoul**

We recommend you to take a long-distance bus (called a "limousine bus") from the airport. It will probably be the simplest option and cost approximately 10,000 KRW. Approximate travel time is 90 minutes. See details below.

**3-2.** You may also take the subway between approximately 6am and 12 midnight, but it may be difficult to carry all your luggage. By subway, come to Hyehwa station (Line 4), Exit 2, heading south to the gate of the Korea National Open University (see **Directions to Dormitory** map below)

**3-3.** A call-van or taxi from Incheon Int'l Airport will cost upwards of 100,000 KRW (appr. \$US 87.00)

**3-4.** You are expected to arrange your own transportation to the EPIK Orientation Venue (NIIED in Seoul) at your own cost. If you have any problems, please **contact EPIK Staff [Soeyoung(010-3899-3928)\*Only available during the OT period until September 29, 2010] before you leave your home to the OT venue so that we can guide you and prepare for your arrival.**

**3-5.** As for the applicants who are already in Korea, we highly recommend you to arrive at the Orientation Venue before 5:00pm on the 25<sup>th</sup> of September.

**3-6. Public Transportation (Bus) Information**

**1) At Incheon Int'l Airport**

The Information Desk is on the first floor (Arrivals Floor). You can buy a ticket there for the limousine bus, or you can also pay the bus driver directly. Take bus No. 6011, final destination: Donam (Sungshin Women's Univ.). You can board the bus at stop 12A or 5B.

**2) Taking Airport Limousine Bus # 6011:**

**Incheon Airport →Sungkyunkwan University (90 minutes)**

- Bus Boarding Section: 12A or 5B
- Fare: 9,000 KRW
- Runs from 5:45am ~ 22:30pm (departs every 20 ~ 30 minutes)
- Bus stop to get off: Hyehwa (Sungkyunkwan University)
- Route of Bus 6011:

1. Incheon International airport	6. Muakjae
2. Entrance of World Cup Stadium	7. Gyungbokgung
3. Yonhui Intersection	8. Angukdong
4. Seodaemun District office	9. Changdeokgung

### 3) After arrival at Sung-kyun-kwan University

Get off the bus at Sung-kyun-kwan University stop. For the bus driver the written word is 성균관대입구. In normal traffic conditions, the trip takes about 90 minutes.

#### ○ Complementary Pick-Up Service from 성균관대입구 to 국립국제교육원

After getting off at 성균관대입구(Sung-kyun-kwan University Ipgoo), you can call NIIED to get some help, then we can dispatch a call-van to pick you up to 국립국제교육원(koong lip kook jae kwo yook won). The call-van service will be provided from **15:00 to 22:00 only**. To use this service, you must report the EPIK staff member at the Incheon Int'l Airport before you ride a public bus.

#### ○ Taking a taxi after you get off the bus

If you have a lot of luggage, you may hail a taxi. It costs about 2,500 KRW. Ask for the Korea National Open University (phonetics: Pahng sohng tohng sheen dae dee koong lip kook jae kwo yook won"). Please show the following information to the taxi driver if needed:

#### ○ Walking directions from the Airport Limousine bus stop to the NIIED Dormitory

- When you get off, turn towards your right and make a left turn at the Watson's Convenience store
- Make an immediate left (you will see a Smoothie King on your left hand side)
- Walk down this street until you reach the end
- Make a right turn onto the main thoroughfare (a 4-lane street with a median)
- Walk straight until you pass the KB bank (yellow letters on grey background)
- Use the crosswalk right after the KB bank and TwoTwo Chicken to reach the gate of the Korea National Open University (refer to the NIIED Dormitory map)


# 4. Orientation Venue: NIIED in Seoul

## 2) From locations in Korea to Orientation Venue

※ *Successful applicants who are already in Korea are expected to come to the EPIK orientation venue on their own.*

### ● Subway from Seoul Station

**Seoul Station -> (Line 4) HyeHwa Station -> Exit 2**

Currently, there is construction blocking the main entrance to the EPIK offices. For your convenience, we have made a new map with a different route to our office.

1. Take Exit #2 at HyeHwa Station (혜화).
2. Follow the sidewalk. At the silver sphere, turn LEFT.
3. When the road Ts, turn RIGHT.
4. Follow the road. There will be a brick wall on your right. When the wall ends, turn RIGHT into the NIIED complex.
5. There will be a basketball court in the center and dormitories on the right and left. The EPIK office is straight ahead. We are located in room #301.

● **From Gangnam Express Bus Terminal** Gangnam Express Bus Terminal -> (Line 3) Chungmuro Station -> (Line 4) HyeHwa Station -> Exit 2 Same as above, from the exit 2, HyeHwa Station

## 5. Before Departing

### 1) What to Pack

Please be sure **to pack the following items in the luggage that you will bring with you to the orientation:**

- Clothing suitable for 6 days including an outdoor field trip
- Personal belongings: laptop, usb, camera, medication, cosmetics, other daily products  
e.g. toothbrush/paste, towels, shampoo, etc  
(Provided products: training manual, limited number of towels, soap, toilet paper)
- All your essential documents (passport and pending documents such as diploma, TEFL certification, teacher's license, proof of teaching experience, etc.)

※ **Important notice for those who come with their siblings or girl/boyfriend:** Please pack separate bags from your dependants' or joint applicants'. Male and female rooms at the NIIED dormitory are run separately in different floors. Packing together may cause a big inconvenience during the orientation. Officially married couples or limited numbers of family dependents (with a proper proof) may be allowed to share a room together, so please let us know in advance.

## 2) Important Note: Regarding Money

- Please bring enough money to last you through your first month (approx. 1 million KRW). You will not receive your first pay check or the Entrance Allowance until the end of the first month of your contract.
- It could be hard to find ATMs that accept foreign debit cards at the orientation venue and perhaps your school area as well. Therefore, please bring enough Korean Won with you or take out money *at the airport* in advance.

## 3) Request for Accompanying Family Dependents

EPIK orientation is only for the incoming successful candidates. If you listed on your application form that you will be bringing dependants to Korea with you, you must reserve accommodations for them in advance and pay for the dependent costs upon arrival at the orientation site. NIIED's dormitory rooms are not fit for children under 10 years of age since the shower room will be shared by all participants. Only limited numbers of rooms have personal bathrooms.

- **Dependent Costs**

- Accommodation per night: Double bed room 15,000 KRW, Single room 25,000 KRW
- A meal: 10,000won (You must pay the complete cost for every meal for the duration of the orientation, rather than paying for select meals on certain days because EPIK must reserve meals with the cafeteria in advance for the total number of estimated participants.)
- Field trip: 30,000won (Including lunch, experiencing cultural activities, transportation, etc)
- Special Dinner on the last day: 25,000KRW

To request accommodations for accompanying family dependents, **you must contact the EPIK Office in Seoul, Korea by Sep. 16(Thursday, Korean Time, +82-2-3668-1347, email: joyworld@mest.go.kr).** This will cost you extra (accommodation, meals, field trip fee, etc.) and the **accommodation is limited, so please request as early as possible.**

## 6. Important Notice

**A dormitory room is shared by two people.**

**No pets are allowed in the dormitory.**

**The dorm rooms do not have private restrooms or shower rooms.**

**Korean power voltage is 220~240.**
