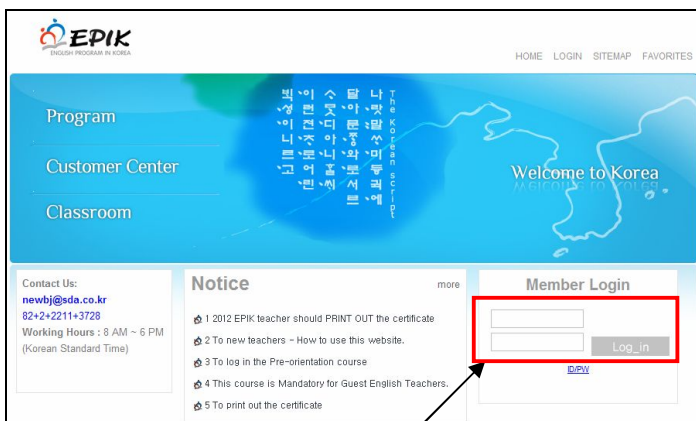
Welcome to EPIK Pre-Orientation Program!!

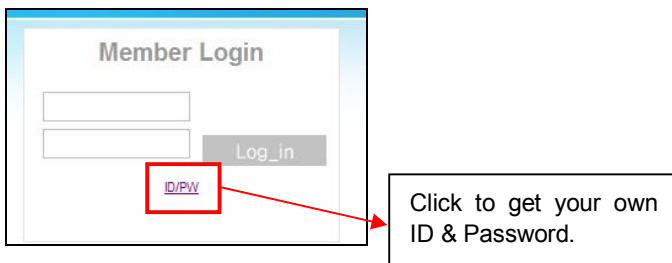

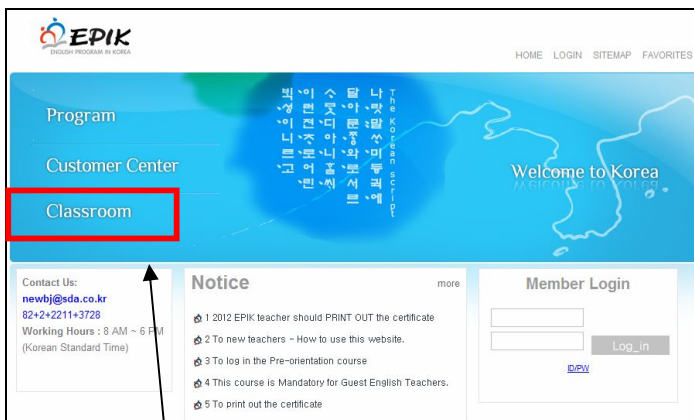

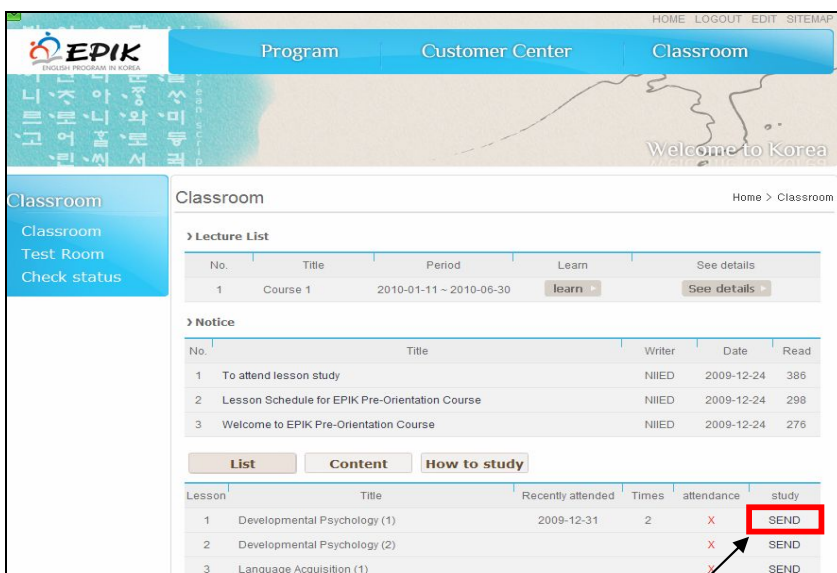

Then you will be able to view the lesson page as illustrated below.

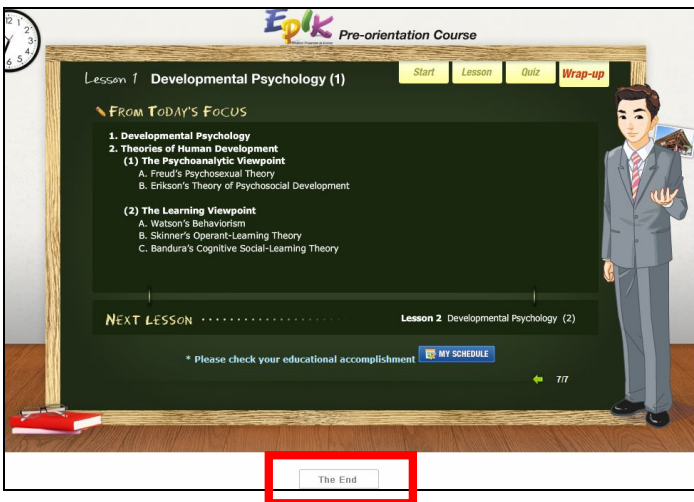

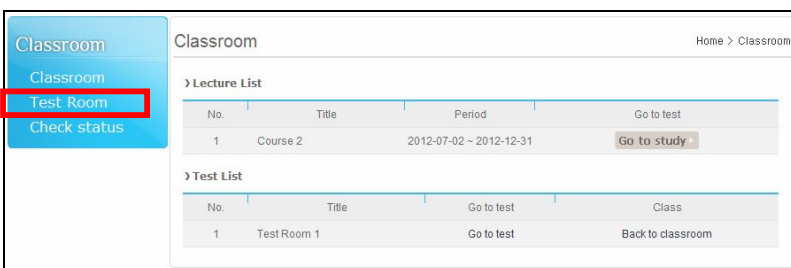

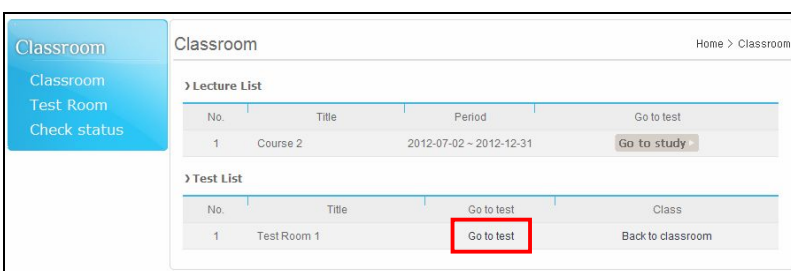

1. You can take a test in the **Test Room [Classroom - Test room]**, click **[Go to test]**.

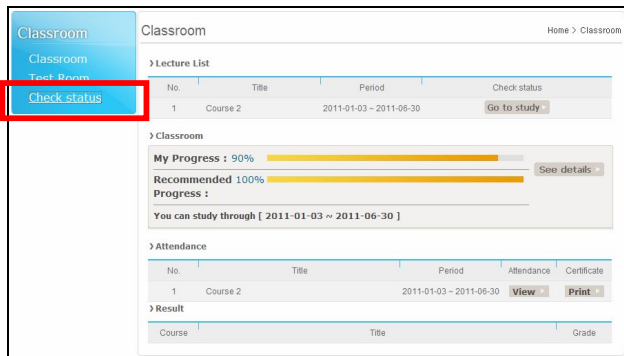

※ If you do not complete **ALL** lessons in the **Pedagogy** and **Korean Studies** sections, you will not be allowed to take the test.

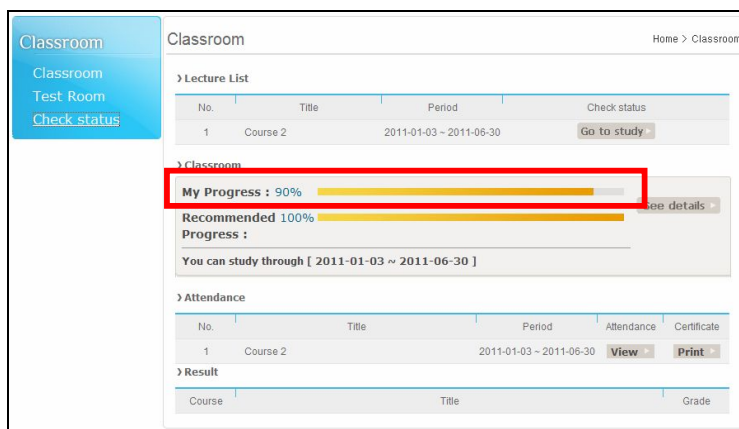
[Check Status]

There are 2 ways to check your schedule & attendance.



Way 1

1. Go to **[Classroom - Check status]**
2. You can check your general progress, attendance and results in this section.
3. If you complete the lesson only in part and not in its entirety, your progress will be shown as 90% in the highlighted section. It will be 100% when you finish the test.





Way 2

1. Go to **[Classroom - Classroom]**
2. Click **[See details]** to check your detailed results and your attendance of lessons.
3. Even if you complete the lesson in part only, your progress will be shown as 100% here, because it shows detailed information of your lesson. But you still need to take the test to get your certificate in general progress.




