## Subway From Seoul Station

### Seoul Station -> (Line 4) HyeHwa Station -> Exit 2

Currently, there is construction blocking the main entrance to the EPIK offices. Please be aware of this and follow the map.

1. Take Exit #2 at HyeHwa Station (혜화).
2. Follow the sidewalk. At the silver sphere, turn LEFT.
3. When the road Ts, turn RIGHT.

# Dormitory Information

### Curfew : Midnight

### Rooms

- 2 teachers share one room.  
(As there is only one key per room, it should be left at the front desk in the lobby whenever you leave the room.)
- Do not enter other rooms(unless both occupants are present).
- Rooms and your belongings are to be kept clean and tidy at all times.
- Lights are to be turned off by 24:00.

### Cafeteria

- Food is provided on a self-service basis.
- After meals, trays and utensils must be returned to the kitchen.
- Please keep your voice down when conversing with others.
- Please do not take any food or utensils out of the cafeteria.

### Shower Room

- Showers are located in the rest rooms and are shared with others.
- Turn the cold water on first, then the hot water.
- Please turn off the water when not in use.

### Athletic Equipment

(1) Exercise Room : Main Office (Staff Room)

- Available Equipment : jump ropes, volleyballs, basketballs, table tennis rackets and balls
- Open hours : To Be Announced
- Procedures : Fill out the record book and check out the equipment.

When you finish using the equipment, check it back in right away.

(2) Gym : 2nd International House (Basement)

- Available Equipment : Basic gym facilities
- Open hours : To Be Announced
- Please understand that you are responsible for your own safety and any damage that are caused by you.

### Post Office

- There is a post office near the dorm.
