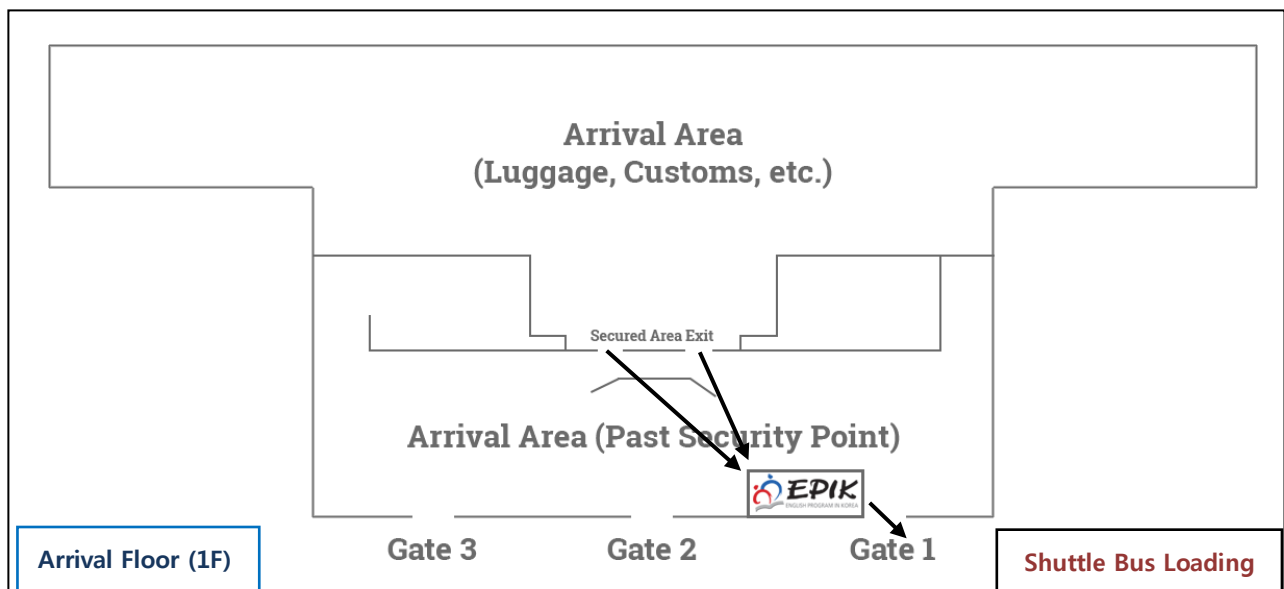

1. Arrival & Pick-up Information

1-1 After you arrive at Gimhae Int'l Airport (**International Terminal - Arrivals Floor: 1F**), please come to the **EPIK registration desk (Booths 3 & 4 on the 1st floor between Gates 1 and 2)** as soon as you are ready to depart to the orientation venue. You will receive a queue sheet with a number that will be called when your bus is ready to depart.

※ If you need time to eat, rest, make phone calls, or exchange money, please do this *before* you arrive at the EPIK desk. However, if you arrive later in the evening, we strongly recommend that you visit the EPIK desk *first* so that you do not miss the last EPIK shuttle bus. Please arrive by 8:00pm at the latest to board by the last scheduled bus at 9:00pm. If you miss the last bus, you should come to the orientation site on your own.

1-2 When your number is called please proceed to the EPIK registration desk and **have the E-2 or F-4 visa page** of your passport ready to show the EPIK Staff.

1-3 Once you have registered at the EPIK registration desk and have received all necessary information, please proceed promptly to **Gate 1** where your EPIK shuttle bus will be waiting.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: Free shuttle bus service will be provided from **Gimhae Int'l Airport to Daegu Haany University on August 19th only** (from approximately **11:00am to 8:00pm**). It will take about 1.5 hours to arrive at the orientation venue.

※ If you are unable to use the shuttle bus service on August 19th, you will be responsible for finding your own way to the orientation site. Any costs you incur will be borne by you.

2. Arriving on your own to the Orientation Venue

2-1 If you do not plan on using the complimentary EPIK shuttle bus service, you are expected to arrange your own transportation to the EPIK Orientation Venue (Daegu Haany University, Samsung Campus) at your own cost. Please contact the EPIK Orientation Staff if you have any problems (Jay: 010-3928-5830).

2-2 Applicants who miss the shuttle bus service on August 19th

If you arrive on August 19th at Gimhae Airport after the last shuttle bus leaves, your only option is to take a taxi to the orientation venue. The base fare will be around 90,000 KRW. Additional fees such as tolls, midnight fare surcharge, and traveling outside of the taxi's operating area may be added.

2-3 Applicants who are in country and will go to the orientation site directly

Applicants who are already in Korea and plan to go directly to the orientation site are required to arrive before **8:00pm** on February 19th.

Getting to Dongdaegu Station

Dongdaegu Station is a major hub in the city of Daegu. You can get here via bus from most major bus terminals. This station is also connected to the KTX and SRT rail lines.

Once here, you have 2 options:

- 1- Take a taxi to the orientation venue (approximately 20,000 KRW)
- 2- Transfer to the Mugunghwa train (2,600 KRW) and get off at Gyeongsan Station (경산역). A taxi from here to the orientation venue will be around 10,000 KRW.

Due to the relative lack of difference between option 1 and 2, it is recommended that you take a taxi from Dongdaegu Station.

4. Before Departing

4-1 What to Pack

Please be sure to pack the following things in the luggage that you will bring with you to the orientation:

- Pre-Orientation certificate
- Clothing suitable for **9 days** including an outdoor OUTFIT
※ Temperatures in Korea in August ranges from 19°C to 32°C (from 66°F to 90°F).
- Personal belongings: alarm clock, umbrella, backpack, laptop, medication, cosmetics, towel, hairdryer and other toiletries **Please bring your own laptop for the Lesson Plan demonstration.**

4-2 Accommodation

- Two teachers will share one room. Male and Female dormitories are separate. If you are married, joint-applicants, please pack accordingly as you cannot dorm together during orientation.
- 1 towel per applicant will be provided.
- Korean power voltage is 220v. **It is recommended for South African and British teachers to bring a plug adapter (circuit adapter) with them.**

4-3 Request for Accompanying Family Dependents

- We **do not** provide accommodations for dependents at orientation. All dependents should arrive after orientation or have other accommodations during orientation.

4-4 Money & Currency Exchange

- Please bring enough money to last you through your first month (approx. 1 million KRW). You will not receive your first pay check or the Entrance Allowance until the end of your first month of the contract.
- It is very difficult to find ATMs that accept foreign debit cards at the orientation venue and possible at your school as well. Please bring enough Korean Won with you or exchange money at the airport.

4-5 Medical Assessment - Mandatory (IMPORTANT)

Date	August 21 st 2018
Fee	Approximately 50,000 Korean Won (Cash) only

※ **Important Notice**

The medical check-up includes certain drug tests. Some over the counter medicine such as sleeping pills, pain medication (including over-the-counter products), or nasal sprays may affect test results even if they were taken 3-4 days prior to the test. All applicants are encouraged to abstain from use of the aforementioned items until the test has been administered. You must bring an official doctor's note when the medication is prescribed for unavoidable medical conditions.

※ **Medical Check-up for Current or Former EPIK teachers**

You are required to arrive **on Thursday, August 23rd by 5:00pm.** Your medical assessment will be done **on August 24th (Friday) at 7:00am.**

4-6 Online Pre-Orientation

- All successful EPIK applicants must complete the online Pre-Orientation course before their arrival. After completion, please turn in your certificate to your homeroom teacher during the orientation.

5. Lost Luggage Protocol

5-1 Please plan for the possibility that your luggage could become lost or misplaced. It is advisable to contact your airline in advance ahead of time regarding how to retrieve lost luggage and pack some extra clothing in your carry-on.

5-2 If your luggage becomes lost, you should **immediately** contact the airline which was responsible for losing your luggage. You can do this by phone or by visiting the airline office at the airport (if your particular airline has an office at Gimhae International Airport).
